

DIRECTOR STATEMENT


In 2009, in one of the most conservative states in Mexico, a burning of the official Biology books of the Ministry of Public Education was organized. While the books were being peeled away, the president of the council complained that they instilled in their children the use of condoms when they should be taught "not to do anything until marriage". For 2010, this state registered 17.6% of the total registered births of mothers under twenty years of age, according to national statistics.

I can still remember a bit of who I was at fifteen. The ME trapped between the loss of childhood and the lack of maturity, would never have heeded my mother's recommendation to keep my virginity until marriage. It was not my father's turn to talk to me about these issues. Everyone in high school knew that most people were having sex, but you could never tell exactly who because it was a secret. That is why you could not trust or consult with those you considered your friends, since as a woman you faced being considered a "bitch" and that was social death.

That stage is full of loneliness, a loneliness that adolescent women are forced to carry whether in abstinence, responsible, irresponsible sexuality, pregnancy, or even the desire to end a pregnancy.

PINKY PROMISE was born from this sensation of adolescent loneliness, its title refers to the infantile promise to keep a secret between girls. A promise that cannot be broken for anything in the world.
